We are excited to bring you the delicious food of LA Kosher while dining outside on VBS's campus. We have taken our time to carefully develop protocols that safeguard guests and staff alike, in accordance with CDC and LA County guidelines.

What You Can Expect

- **Reservations are required** in order to maintain social distancing and due to our limited seating capacity.
- **Households together.** As of March 12, 2021, people from no more than three separate households may be seated at the same table. Tables have a maximum capacity of six people.
- **Face masks are required.** Please support healthy dining out for everyone by bringing your own mask from home and wearing it any time you're not seated at your table.
- **Hand sanitizer will be available.** We will have hand sanitizer stations for your use. Staff will wash their hands more frequently and will be wearing face masks & face shields.
- **Your table will be set upon your arrival.** To minimize exposure, all silverware will be rolled in napkins. Dishes and glassware will be brought after you have been seated. Condiments will be in single-serving ramekins.
- **Tables will be spaced eight feet apart.** In order to maintain a six-foot distance between guests, tables will be spaced eight feet apart. Staff will do their best to stay six feet away from you and will minimize tableside contact.
- **We are currently limiting dining experiences to 120 minutes.** This allows us time to thoroughly sanitize and prepare for each seating. Thank you in advance for understanding.
- **We are expanding efforts to keep surfaces sanitized.** Tables, chairs, and all high-touch surfaces such as handrails, doorknobs, handles, and facets are being cleaned with increased frequency.

What We Request

- **Don't dine out if you have any symptoms.** This includes a cough, fever, or difficulty breathing. If you do, please stay home.
- **Maintain social distance.** Keep six feet between you and other diners at all times. It is considerate and helps minimize risks.
- **Wash your hands.** When you arrive, take a moment to wash your hands or use one of our hand sanitizer stations. Our staff are washing their hands with increased frequency too!
- **Wear a face mask.** Out of consideration for others, face masks are required on campus whenever you're not seated at your table. Our staff will also be wearing masks & face shields.
- **For safety,** no outside food, beverages, or non-essential personal items will be allowed such as birthday cakes, desserts, balloons and presents. The one exception is a closed/sealed bottle of wine which will be opened by your server and kept at your table.
